


## **Thunderbird:**

This guide describes the process for setting up a MAGIX email account in **Thunderbird**. Other email clients are based on the same menus and work with the same settings.

First go to the menu and click on **File > New > Existing Mail Account**.

Enter the **Name**, the **Email Address** and your created **Password** that will be used for the account.



A screenshot of the Thunderbird account creation dialog box. It contains the following fields and options:



After you click **Continue**, Thunderbird will automatically attempt to find the correct settings. If this attempt is unsuccessful, click on **Advanced Config**.

The settings for the inbox server (**IMAP**) and the outbox server (**SMTP**) vary because MAGIX works with different email services for old domains and new domains.

The settings that must be entered here can be found by logging in to the **Control Center** and clicking on **Email**. Simply find the appropriate mailbox and click on **Options > Email Program Settings**.

Here is an example for a newer domain:

### Email program settings

If you wish to access your email account with an email program, you can use the following data.

#### Access via IMAP

IMAP server:	imap.app.magix-online.com
SMTP server:	smtp.app.magix-online.com
Username:	Email address of the account
Password:	Password of the account

#### Access via POP3

POP3 server:	pop.app.magix-online.com
SMTP server:	smtp.app.magix-online.com
Username:	Email address of the account
Password:	Password of the account

This means that the following server hostname must be entered:

Incoming: **imap.app.magix-online.com**

Outgoing: **smtp.app.magix-online.com**

All domains that were registered before the middle of 2010 still work on the old system. For these domains, the following server information must be entered:

Incoming: **mail.magix-website.com**

Outgoing: **mail.magix-website.com**

Enter your email address here as your **username**. The final step is to set the **SSL** (Encryption), **Authentication** and **Ports** as shown in the picture. The SSL should be set to **SSL/TLS** with an **Encrypted Password**. The input port should be set to **993** and the output port to **465**.

You can finalize the process by clicking on **Create Account**. And that is all that is necessary to send and receive emails with Thunderbird.
